THE PROBLEM

When you cannot afford a leak.

The headlines do not come from bad actors. They come from a crew member's Instagram story. A catering team's group chat. A badge photo that was never supposed to be posted. Or a hotel Wi-Fi router that was compromised six months before your event arrived.

Most event production companies treat confidentiality as a posture. Today it is an engineering problem. A standard corporate event has twenty to forty people on the production crew, each arriving with a personal smartphone, each with a personal social presence, each one hour from posting a photo that identifies the client, the venue, the guest list, or the subject matter. None of them are trying to do harm. **The leak surface is structural.**

Layer in the venue network — a shared hotel or conference Wi-Fi system that was designed for guest convenience, not for your threat model — and the attack surface extends beyond anyone in the room. The following are not hypotheticals. They are the public record.

DOCUMENTED THREAT INTELLIGENCE

State-sponsored actors have been targeting hotel and venue networks for more than a decade.

DarkHotel APT

Kaspersky · 2014

A multi-year espionage campaign compromising luxury hotel Wi-Fi networks to target executives in **defense industrial base, pharmaceutical, electronics, and energy policy** sectors. CEOs, SVPs, R&D directors. The actor selectively attacks a single target per hotel visit, exfiltrates cleanly, and disappears.

APT28 / Fancy Bear

FireEye /

Mandiant · 2017

Attributed to the Russian GRU. Coordinated hotel Wi-Fi attacks across **seven European countries and the Middle East**, targeting business and government travelers. Credentials harvested on hotel networks, used to infiltrate organizational networks after the victims returned home.

Operation Masquerade

FBI / NSA / Allies

· 2026

A joint advisory from the FBI, NSA, and allied Western intelligence services warned that APT28 had compromised **more than 18,000 internet-exposed routers globally**, providing persistent access into 200-plus organizations through peripheral network appliances routinely overlooked in institutional cybersecurity planning.

Decibel Secure is built for the events that cannot afford any of this. The leak surface is engineered out of the production model. The network the event runs on is ours, not the venue's.

THE CAPABILITY STACK

Seven pillars of secure **event** production.

Every Decibel Secure engagement is scoped to the client's specific threat model. The capability stack is consistent.

PILLAR 01**Cleared & NDA-Bound Crew**

Every crew member signs a project-specific NDA. Cleared personnel sourced for engagements that require it. Small, senior, vetted team. No rotating freelancers.

PILLAR 02**Device Control & Faraday Protocol**

Signal-blocking Faraday pouches at check-in, secured lockers with credentialed retrieval, or no-device zones. Decibel manages inventory, intake workflow, and chain of custody.

PILLAR 03 · YOUR NETWORK, NOT THEIRS**Private Network Infrastructure — your event is secure. The hotel network is not.**

Decibel deploys a dedicated private network for your event, isolated from any venue or public infrastructure. Enterprise-grade firewalls, segmented VLANs, managed access. Your attendees, presenters, AV, registration, and livestream run on a network we built for you — not the hotel's, not the conference next door's, not a shared ballroom router that also serves a lobby bar.

Your network, not theirs.

PILLAR 04**Venue Security & Badged Entry**

Metal detection. Layered credentialing with visually distinct access tiers. Pre-cleared attendee manifests. Coordinated entry and egress timing. Access revocation protocols.

PILLAR 05**Information Discipline**

No attendee social media. No personal photography. No live streaming. Any capture is executed by pre-cleared Decibel crew under the client's content approval workflow.
